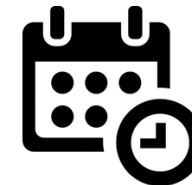

There are now more appointments with GPs and Nurses available in Doncaster, making it easier for you access an appointment at a time that suits you.

- Do you find it difficult to attend an appointment during the working day?
- Are you a busy parent with small children?
- Do you rely on working carers to take you to appointments?

If so, this service is here to support you.

Extra appointments are being provided in the evening and at weekends across Doncaster. The service is an extension of your GP practice and offers routine and same day appointments with a range of clinicians including GPs, Nurses and other Healthcare Professionals.

When using the service, you may not see your usual doctor, but we do employ clinicians from local practices where possible.

With your consent, our clinicians will be able to access your healthcare record to ensure they can offer the right treatment for you, and prescribe medication or refer you for further treatment if necessary.

If you do not consent then your GP practice will not be able to offer you one of these appointments.

Who can access these appointments?

Anyone registered with a GP practice in Doncaster.

How do I book a GP or Nurse appointment?

Simply contact your GP practice in the usual way. Please tell your receptionist if you prefer to be seen in an evening or at the weekend and you may be offered you an appointment at an Extended Access Hub, if this is right for you.
